A 2-month-old infant who went missing for several days was found after investigators went to the Oklahoma County Detention Center where the mother, Megan Rogers, is currently being held. Afraid that her child would end up in the biological father's custody, Rogers had refused to tell investigators the baby's whereabouts. With no credible clues on the infant's location, Child Protective Services reached out to Investigator Brandon Davis of the Oklahoma County Sheriff's office for help.

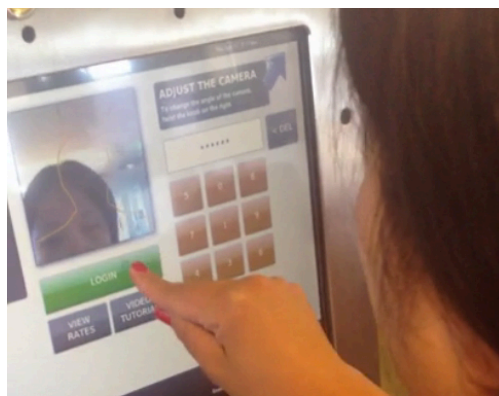
